## INTERVIEW 9/20/04

## PRESENT WERE ELDERS IN PALMER, MA. CONGREGATION INTERVIEWED: Also present was her husband, both of the West Springfield, MA congregation , Elder, Phone: 413-LOCATION: Palmer Kingdom Hall, 133 Old Palmer Road, Palmer, MA. TIME: About 8:45 PM TRANSCRIBED NOTES OF BROTHER FOLLOWS: was asked to make her statement as to why we were here. After prayer by Brother She said that beginning at age four her father, had sexually abused her. Asked if there was penetration and she said "yes" and that it was vaginal, oral and also sodomy. During these events she says her father would ask her to pray and he would quote scriptures particularly 2 Peter 2:22 (The dog has returned to its own vomit) when she would sometimes vomit. Asked over how long a time this occurred and she said it terminated when she became older. There were lots of things happening in the family—terminated about age 13. Additionally she was raped on coming home from school by someone she didn't know. She alleges that her father was physically abusive toward his wife and her sister. He was very angry, violent and "controlling". She was asked if she ever got professional help and she said she did from a brother ( ) at about age seventeen. She was asked if she had been examined by a doctor when these alleged incidents took place and she said she saw a doctor at age four because of rashes etc but he apparently did not recognize abuse.

She alleges that he alluded to Judges 20:29,30 and if the girls revealed what he was doing he could do the same with them and scatter their remains in a field and no one would find them. They considered this a threat upon their life.

Asked if she would be willing to face her father with these accusations if it came to judicial action and she said she would rather not.
