Dear Brother [REDACTED],

Since you are the brother who is in charge of my accusations against [REDACTED] I should like to give you the latest report on her misbehavior.

November 30<sup>th</sup> we were in the Framingham Court because of charges brought against me as having broken a restraining order brought by my daughter [REDACTED] of West Springfield Congregation. They were dropped against me as the district attorney found that my daughter [REDACTED] and son-in-law, [REDACTED] had given him a false report.

My wife, [REDACTED] and I had brought a friend, [REDACTED] with us for the trial. At one point [REDACTED] went into the ladies bathroom at that time [REDACTED] verbally accosted her. [REDACTED] was terribly upset by her attack. She was afraid that [REDACTED] would physically attack her.

With the trial dismissed, the group with [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], left before us. As they were leaving the building [REDACTED] gave us an awful look, if looks could kill she would have killed all of us. [REDACTED] tried to motion her back as she was leaving but [REDACTED] would have none of it.
